

Delegation Rule Management

The SAQ has reviewed, simplified and improved the delegation rule.

The advantages of the new procedures are:

- You can now have more than one delegation rule
 - There's no limit on the number of agents that can represent you.
- Each agent has access only to the products it represents.
- Each agent has access only to the offers for which it is registered.

This allows the agent delegated by the supplier to act as the supplier's representative on SAQ-B2B for the products the agent represents. Note that the agent has to have an active SAQ-B2B account under its name.

In designating an agent, the supplier agrees that the information about its business on SAQ-B2B can be securely and confidentially shared with the agent for the agent's benefit. A supplier can revoke the rights of any agent it has designated.

Designated agents are authorized to take the following actions on behalf of the supplier:

- submit a new product offer (AO/OS) as part of a product selection process or a renewal offer (RC);
- submit a private import request (DI) or renewal request (RP);
- submit a price change request;
- confirm, modify and/or refuse an order for products to be sold in the SAQ network
 - For private import orders, only the supplier is authorized to accept orders.

The agent will also be able to submit private import requests and renewals provided it has been authorized by the SAQ.

The rule does not authorize, at any time, an agent to submit products for a promotion.

A supplier that wants to authorize an agent to sign up products for a promotional program and make the related financial commitments has to complete the Power of Attorney for the Purchase of Promotions by an Agent form and submit it via the Contact Us module with the following category and subject:

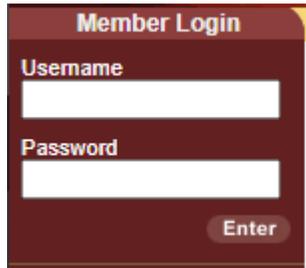

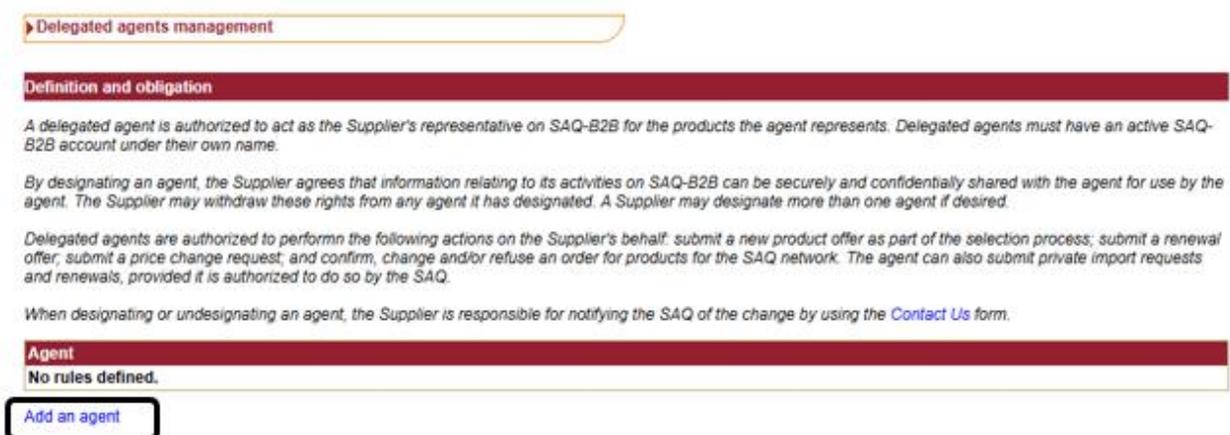

Assigning an agent

- You can find your SAQ supplier number on a product offer.*
- If it is for an offer, enter the offer number, which will be found in the SAQ Catalog of Offers and Private Import Requests module.
- Choose the distribution network.
- The agent should be able to send you its SAQ agent number and officially registered name.

Copy the information onto all required lines.

***Note:** at any time, you can contact the Business Relations Assistance Service (SARA) to check your SAQ supplier number.

Important!

If you retain the services of more than one agent, be sure to enter the right agent number for each product.
